

# Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord April 2, 2023

This weekend we celebrate Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord when we commemorate Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem. With this, we begin Holy Week. During this week we reflect on the Passion and Death that Jesus underwent to win Salvation for us. The events of Holy Week and Easter remind us that the victory of Jesus can be ours if we follow in His ways.

# Sacred Triduum

The Easter Triduum begins with the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, reaching its high point in the Easter Vigil, and closing with Evening Prayer on Easter Sunday.

Good Friday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until

age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

Here are a few updates from our March meeting:

- ~The Dedication of the outside St. Joseph Statue will take place on Saturday, May 13<sup>th</sup>, after the 4 pm Mass. Bishop Koenig will be here for the Mass and Dedication.
- ~Easter Season Mass Setting is Mass of Christ the Savior and the Memorial Acclamation is "Save Us Savior". Also, starting with the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Easter, we will be reciting the Apostles' Creed instead of the Nicene Creed.
- ~The Filipino Inculturation will take place on Sunday, May 21st. Couples for Christ will be playing music during the 10:30 am Mass. An Agape will follow with Filipino foods, dancing, a history of their culture, and many other areas of interest. Mark your calendars for this special event!!



The Liturgy Committee agreed that we will say the Apostles' Creed during the Easter season beginning with the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Easter (Divine Mercy Sunday). Saying the Apostles' Creed, instead of the usual Nicene Creed, more closely reflects our baptism in Christ, as well as, catechizes the assembly regarding the holiness and full baptismal character of the Easter season. Our call is to the continuing conversion begun in baptism. It is a call that requires vigilance that our heart does not wander from the voice of our God. #### **CHALICE MINISTRY**



# THE EXTRAORDINARY GRACE OF DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY, APRIL 16, 2023

Regarding the graces of Divine Mercy Sunday, Jesus told St Faustina "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment." (Diary, 699)

We only have this incredible opportunity once a year on Divine Mercy Sunday (the Sunday after Easter) and the Divine Mercy Vigil Mass on Saturday. All we have to do is make a valid confession (up to 20 days before), receive Holy Communion with the intention of receiving this promised grace and have trust in God's Mercy.

As we prepare to receive Holy Communion, offer up a prayer like this: Lord Jesus Christ, You promised St. Faustina that the soul that has been to Confession (I have) and the soul that receives Holy Communion with trust in Divine Mercy (I am) will receive complete forgiveness of all sins and punishment. Lord, please give me this grace. Jesus, I trust in you.
