**AN EVENING GRIEF SUPPORT GROUP** will begin here at St. Polycarp on Thursdays in October. Look for more information about the evening grief support group in future bulletins.

Before the support group begins, a series from **FORMED**, "Eternal Rest: The Art of Dying Well", will be shown at 7 pm on four consecutive Thursdays: September 26 and October 3, 10, & 17. (Room location to be announced in future bulletin.)

In each of the four sessions -*The Story of Death, The Afterlife, The Hour of Our Death, and The Faithful Departed* – a half hour video will be shown, followed by reflective discussion. "Eternal Rest" presents the Catholic Church's teaching about death and God's response to it with wisdom and truth, gentleness and compassion, so we can think about and prepare for death in the light of Jesus Christ, the Author of life.
